Bidding is restricted to Filipino Citizens sole proprietorship/partnership, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

Bidding is restricted to Florida citizens who are incorporated in Florida or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest in outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Florida citizens pursuant to Part 19, Florida Administrative Code and subject to Government Code Act 108.

The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by Interested Bidders on **February 23, 2021** onwards, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays on the address stated upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and in the website of the Procuring Entity at [www.lss.pnp.gov.ph](http://www.lss.pnp.gov.ph), provided that Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the date of submission of bids.
