The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by Interested Bidders on **August 11, 2021** onwards, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays on the address stated upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and in the website of the Procuring Entity at www.lss.pnp.gov.ph, provided that Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the date of submission of bids.

Bids shall be opened in the presence of the bidders' authorized representatives who will attend at the said activity at the address provided above. Late bids shall not be accepted.
